

## Fast and Easy Tube Pillow Case

### Supplies:

3/4 yard of main fabric  
3/8 yard of contrast fabric  
2 1/2 to 4 inches of piping fabric

### Directions:

Lay out the 3/8 yard of contrast fabric with the right side facing up. Iron your trim fabric in half with the right sides out making a long width of the fabric piece. Lay this piece on top of the contrast piece with the raw edges even. Place the large main fabric right side down on top of the others meeting the raw edges again and pin together along the raw edge.

Now fan fold the large piece (about a 4" width fan) so it will fit inside of the contrast end when it is folded in half. Next bring the contrast fabric up and over the main fan folded fabric and pin with the other pinned raw edges. Your tube is ready to sew.

Stitch across the raw pinned edges with a 5/8 inch seam. Remove the pins and turn the tube right side out. Press and trim the side edges to even up the pillow case.

Finish with a serged seam across the side and bottom with right sides together or fold wrong sides together and seam, then turn to the inside and stitch again to make a French seam.
