Five Inch Collection Quilt

23 1/2" x 23 1/2"

This cute little quilt can be made for a wall hanging, baby, or doll. We used a pack of 45, five inch square fabrics from Moda.

Divide your pack into colors. Example, all greens together, all creams together, etc.

Pick 16 of your larger prints for the center squares.

Pick out seven light squares for border one. Set aside.

Pick out ten darkest fabrics for the second border. Set aside.

For the last row pick out 10 squares for the larger rectangles and one light square for the corner stones.

Trim the sixteen squares you intend to use for the center to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Piece together in four rows of four.

Border one: Cut six of your lights into three 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Piece together four length-wise. Cut one square into four 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares for corner blocks. Add borders to center.

Border two: Using ten darker blocks, cut each into nine 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. You will have some left over. Mix them up and sew together for next border.

Border three: Using ten of the remaining squares, cut each into two 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Mix them up, and sew together length-wise. You will have extra. Cut one remaining light fabric into 4 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares for the cornerstones. Sew borders on.

Layer with batting, and backing.

Quilt as desired.

For 2 1/4" straight grain binding, you will need 1/4 yd.
