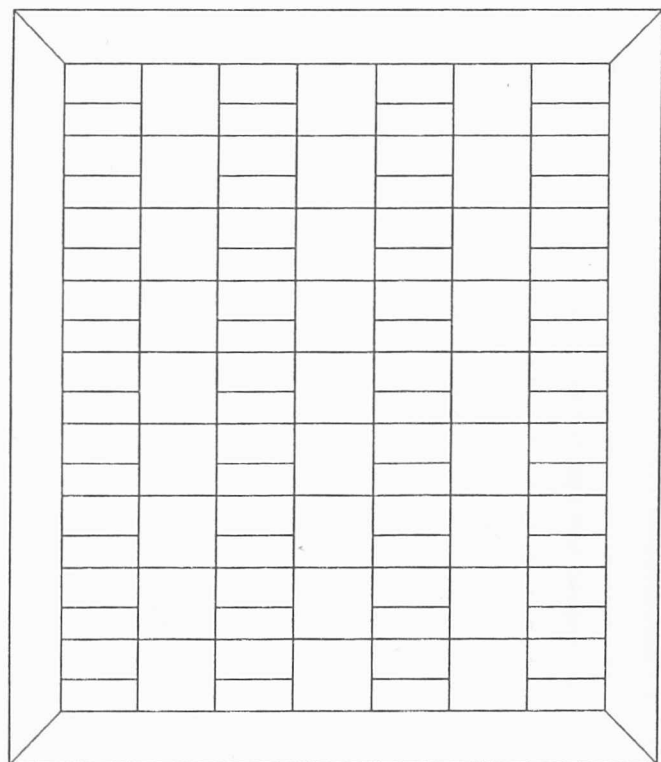

## Stacked Nickels

42" x 37 1/2"

**Fabric Needed:** 1 stack of forty 5" squares  
1 yard for sashing strips & border  
1/2 yard for binding  
1 yard for backing

Cut each of your forty squares into 2 1/2" x 5" rectangles. Randomly sew eighteen rectangles together on the longer side. Repeat three more times so you will have four columns of stacked nickels.

Cut your sashing fabric into three, 5 inch strips.

Sew stacked nickel strips and sashing strips together.

For Borders, cut four, 3 1/2" strips. Sew side borders on first, trim, then add top and bottom borders. Trim even.

Layer with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

Yardage for binding fabric was based on 2 1/2" straight of grain binding.
